

Patient Information Notice on Data Protection

Information according to Articles 13, 14, and 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Dear Patient,

Protecting your personal data is important to us. In accordance with the GDPR, we are obligated to inform you about the purposes for which we collect, store, or share your data. This notice also outlines your rights regarding data protection.

1. Responsible Entity:

2. Sources and Data Used:

We process personal data received in the context of our business relationship and, if necessary, from doctors or therapists along with a medical prescription or with your consent.

3. Purpose and Legal Basis of Processing:

- a) Contractual Obligations (Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR): To fulfill the treatment contract and provide medical planning based on your health condition.
- b) Legitimate Interests (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR): For example, in the case of legal claims or disputes.
- c) Legal Obligations (Art. 6(1)(c) GDPR): For compliance with commercial and tax laws requiring data retention.

4. Data Recipients:

We share data only if required by law or contract (e.g., doctors, therapists, insurance providers, billing centers, tax consultants).

5. Data Retention:

Your data is stored as long as necessary for the business relationship and according to legal obligations (up to 10 years), or longer if legally justified.

6. International Data Transfers:

Your data is not transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area.

7. Your Rights:

You have the right to access, correct, delete, restrict processing, and data portability as per Articles 15-20 GDPR. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.

The legal basis is Article 9(2)(h) GDPR in conjunction with §22(1)(1)(b) BDSG.

Right to Object (Art. 21 GDPR):

You may object at any time, based on your situation, to processing under public interest or legitimate interest grounds. In such cases, your data will no longer be processed unless compelling reasons are demonstrated.
